SHOW HOURS 9-4

Show Motel: This year we will be using the Sleep Inn & Suites. There is a block of 50 rooms reserved. You must mention Madison Cat Club when making the reservation. The hotel is about 2 miles from the restaurant for the banquet.

You must call the local number in order to receive the club rates.

Bring your swimsuits! There is a 24 hour indoor pool and whirlpool for your enjoyment.

Each room has a coffee maker, refrigerator and microwave.

There is a morning medley breakfast offered each morning in the LARGE breakfast room.

If you need a tub, you will need to request a Double Queen (\$85.00). The King rooms (\$75.00) have a shower only.

This is a 3 story hotel, but they have a lovely (and roomy) elevator.

Rules: It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to familiarize themselves with the ACFA Show Rules. The show will be scored for ACFA Inter-American and Regional awards according to the ACFA bylaws. Winners must be present to receive final awards or excused by the Show Manager prior to closing of the show. A copy of the A.C.F.A. Show Rules is available to everyone at www.acfacat.com or through the ACFA Central Office (417) 725-1530. Transfers for cats achieving Championship and Grand Championship status during the show on Saturday must be made with the Master Clerk during the show on Saturday. No transfers will be allowed on Sunday morning unless the cat is a Sunday only entry or was absent on Saturday & will be shown on Sunday.

REGISTRATION NUMBERS: Kittens, Cats, Alters and Household Pets must be registered with ACFA in order to be eligible for scoring for end of the year awards. That number must be present in the master catalog. If you do not have an ACFA registration number, Cats and Alters must pay a \$5 per day listing fee. Kittens and Household Pets are exempt. However, per Show Rule Article IV, Sec 2c:

“All Bengals, Korats, Pixiebob Longhairs/Shorthairs, Singapuras and all cats shown in the NBC Class must have an ACFA registration number. All Bengals must have an ACFA registration number to be allowed inside the show hall for any purpose. A Bengal litter registration number shall suffice in regard to 'kittens for sale'.”

Liability: Neither Madison Cat Club Inc., Show Management, any member of Class Act Cat Club, nor the Jefferson County Fairgrounds will be responsible for any loss, damage, injury or accidents to animals or property or assume any liability whatsoever for injury, loss, or damage to any person, animal or property.

Feline Health: Madison Cat Club Inc., requests all cats in the show hall must be free of illness 21 days prior to the show. It is strongly recommended that all cats have been inoculated for enteritis, rhinotracheitis, calici virus and rabies. Entries must be free of ear mites, fleas and fungus; any animal showing signs of illness or parasites will be excused from the show hall immediately - NO EXCEPTIONS! Please bring current immunization records for all cats in show hall for your cat's protection. Trim those claws prior to the show or a Class Act Cat Club member will trim them for a fee of \$2.00.

Kittens: All kittens must be 4 months old to be allowed in the show hall, for sale or show- born on or before March 10, 2010, to show on Saturday and March 11, 2010, to show on Sunday.

Household Pets: HHP's will be judged in all 8 rings. HHP's must adhere to the same rules as cats in the Championship classes. All HHP's over 8 months must be spayed or neutered.

Sales: Minimum price for cat/kitten is \$150. No cats/kittens may be sold from carriers, under tables, or from cars in the parking lot. NO EXCEPTIONS!! All Kittens/Cats for sale must have their litter registration, proof of vaccinations, and be a minimum of 4 months old – born on or before March 10, 2010.

Additional Information: Single cages are 22x22x22. Double cages are 22x22x44. Sales cages are available to exhibitors only. The club will provide litter at the show hall; owners must bring food, water, Cage Curtains/coverings and all necessary supplies needed to present your cat for judging or exhibition.

Novice Exhibitors: We are thrilled to help you before and during the show. Please contact the entry clerk so you will be benched with an experienced exhibitor or a club member. For additional information, please contact the show manager or entry clerk.

AWARDS: Cats must be present to receive final wins unless excused by the show manager in writing prior to the closing time of the show.

TRANSFERS: If your cat or alter is an OPEN on Saturday and receives 4 winners ribbons, you must claim the championship with the Master Clerk before the show starts on Sunday in order to be able to show your cat on Sunday. This applies to cats paying listing fees as well. Household Pets do not have their titles transferred as they must be claimed and verified through Central Office.

PLEASE NOTE: No animal may be left in the show hall overnight.

CHILDREN: This show is for the display and competition of cats. While well-behaved children are welcome, two days at a show can be very boring and tiring for them. Consider bringing activity books to help occupy their time. Please keep this in mind and be respectful of all those exhibitors around you who may not have young children.

****BENCHING REQUESTS:** End of row benching is reserved for the handicapped, ring clerks, Master Clerk, and show committee. Your request will be honored as best we can. Once the benching chart is done – it is final. The entry clerk will do their very best to honor the first (**and only the first**) request on your entry. Please, no negative benching requests!

Entry Confirmations: If you do not receive a confirmation by July 5th, 2010, please contact the entry clerk to ensure that your entry was received. The club is not responsible for late or lost entries.
