Saturday: Check in 7:30-8:30 a.m. Judging starts at 9:00 a.m.

Sunday: Check in 7:30-8:00 a.m. Judging starts at 8:30 a.m.

<u>CLOSING DATE</u>: Registration will close on June 30, 2012, or when the 200th entry is received, whichever comes first. If you have not received your confirmation by June 30, 2012, please call the entry clerk for confirmation that your entry was received. Madison Cat Club is not responsible for entries lost or delayed or lost in the regular mail or email.

ENTRY FEES: Please refer to the Summary Sheet for prices and other registration details.

RULES: The show will be conducted according to the American Cat Fanciers Association (ACFA) show rules, which are available for \$7.00 from the ACFA Central Office, P.O. Box 1949, Nixa, MO 65714-1949. Phone (417) 725-1530. The rules are also available on the ACFA web site, http://www.acfacats.com.

LIABILITY: Neither the show management, nor any member of the club, nor the Madison Cat Club can be held liable for the loss of, or accident to, the cats, carriers or other personal property of any exhibitor or injury to any person, animal or property. We reserve the right to refuse any admission and to remove any person or animal from the show hall in the best interest of the show and exhibitors.

CLERKS: Clerks will be paid the equivalent of one entry fee for clerking both days. Lunch will be provided. If interested, please indicate on your entry form. Clerks will be assigned according to experience and will be paid at the end of the show. Please do not deduct from your fees.

CHILDREN: This show is for the display and competition of cats. While well-behaved children are welcome, two days at a show can be very boring and tiring for them. If an exhibitor or spectator brings a disruptive child to the show hall, the child will be asked to leave. There will be no refund of entry or admission fees.

HEALTH: This is a non-vetted show; no veterinary inspection will be required prior to benching. All cats and kittens must be immunized against feline enteritis, calici virus, and rhinotracheitis. Any animal from a cattery or house where there has been any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days prior to the show will not be allowed in the show hall. Entries must be free of fleas, ear mites, and fungus (ringworm). The show management will remove any cats that show signs of contagious illness or disease. All claws must be trimmed; if claws are not trimmed, it will be done at the show at the exhibitor's expense.

KITTENS: No kitten under the age of 4 months will be allowed in the show hall. No cats or kittens will be allowed to be kept under the show bench or under grooming tables. Kittens in the show hall must have been born on or before November 7th (for Saturday) or 8th (for Sunday), 2012.

SUPPLIES AND CAGES: The club will provide litter. Bring your own food and water dishes, cat food, and litter pans. Single cages (included with entry fee) are 22 x 22 x 23. Double cages are 22 x 22 x 45. *Novice exhibitors: Please bring coverings for the top, sides, and bottom of the cage.*

SALES: Sales cages are available only to exhibitors. No cat or kitten may be sold for less than \$150.00 at this show. No sales are permitted from carriers under the table or from vehicles in the parking lot.

FOOD: People food will be available in the show hall. This is a non-smoking show hall.

AWARDS: The show will be scored for ACFA Inter-American and Regional awards. Prior to the end of the advertised show hours, cats must be present to receive final wins unless excused by the show manager.

HOUSEHOLD PETS: Household pets will be judged in all ten rings. They must be immunized at least three weeks prior to the show, and if they are over eight months old, they must be spayed or neutered. Although household pets may be declawed, all remaining claws must be trimmed.

TRANSFERS: Transfers for the show on Sunday must be made with the master clerk before the start of show on Sunday. All championship entries should be registered at the time of the show. Novice exhibitors: If your cat wins enough points on Saturday, you may need to make a transfer. We're happy to help you.
