Show Hours: Both Days: Check-in 7:30 – 8:30 am Judging is from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm. Public show hours both Saturday and Sunday – 9 am to 4 pm.

You may also enter on Eclerk!

Show Hall: Northern Wisconsin State Fairgrounds, Creative Arts Building C – 331 Jefferson Avenue, Chippewa Falls, WI 54729. This is a non-smoking, wheelchair accessible show hall. This building has central heat, but not air conditioning. This show is early enough in our northern Wisconsin spring, that it should not be an issue. No animal may be left in the show hall overnight. People food will be available for purchase in the show hall.

Show Hotel: Sleep Inn & Suites (29 Pines) – 5872 33rd Avenue, Eau Claire, WI 54703 – (715) 874-2900, www.sleepinneauclaire.com. Rates: \$79.00 plus tax for single or double. Additional \$10.00 fee for each person over 2 per room. Pet deposit has been waived. A block of rooms is being held until March 12, 2013. Please mention the "Chippewa Valley Cat Club Block" when reserving a room to receive special rate.

Rules: This is a non-vetted show; no veterinary inspection will be required prior to benching. The show will be conducted according to American Cat Fanciers Association (ACFA) show rules which are available for \$7 from the ACFA Central Office, PO Box 1949, Nixa, MO 65714-1949, Phone (417) 725-1530. The rules are also available on the ACFA website, www.acfacat.com. The show will be scored for ACFA Inter-American and Regional awards. Cats must be present to receive final wins unless excused by show manager prior to the closing time of show.

Liability: Neither the Chippewa Valley Cat Club, nor show management, nor any member of the club, nor the Northern Wisconsin State Fairgrounds will be responsible for any loss, damage, injury or accidents to animals or property or assume any liability whatsoever for injury, loss, or damage to any person, animal or property. We reserve the right to refuse any admission and to remove any person or animal from the show hall in the best interest of the show and exhibitors.

Children: Well-behaved children are welcome. If an exhibitor or spectator does bring a disruptive child to the show hall, he or she will be asked to leave. There will be no refund of entry or admission fees.

Feline Health: The club strongly advises that all cats and kittens be immunized against feline enteritis, rhinotracheitis, calici virus, and rabies at least three weeks before the show. Any animal from a cattery or house where there has been any infectious or contagious illness within 21 days before the show will not be allowed in the show hall. Any animal showing signs of illness or parasites will be excused from the show hall immediately. Please bring current immunization records for all cats in show hall for your cat's protection. All claws must be trimmed. Household pets over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered.

Supplies: The club will provide litter. Bring your own food and water dishes, cat food, and litter pans. Single cages are 22 x 22 x 22. Double cages are 22 x 22 x 44. Grooming spaces are 22 x 24 x 44. Please bring coverings for the top, sides, and bottom of the cage.

Sales: Minimum price for cat/kitten is \$150. No cats/kittens may be sold from carriers, under tables, or from cars in the parking lot. No exceptions!! All Kittens/Cats for sale must have their litter registration, proof of vaccinations, and be a minimum of 4 months old – born on or before December 14, 2011. Sales cages are available to exhibitors only.

Transfers: Transfers for the show on Sunday must be made with the master clerk before the start of the show on Sunday. All championship entries should be registered at the time of the show. Novice exhibitors: If your cat wins enough points on Saturday, you may need to make a transfer. There is a form that you will need to complete with the Master Clerk, who will be happy to help you.
