Cages & Cat Supplies: Cat litter will be provided. Bring your own litter pans, cat food, dishes, grooming supplies and cage coverings. For each cat entered, the exhibitor gets a half cage which measures 22" x 22" x 22". Exhibitors supplying their own cage will be charged for a double cage. Transport your cat in a carrier.

Kittens: All kittens must be at least 4 months old (born on or before June 4, 2014) to enter the show hall and to be shown. Minimum sale price - \$200 No sales cage unless entered in this show.

Catalog Advertising: Full page = \$100, Half page = \$50, Quarter page = \$25, Business Card size = \$10. All ad copy must be camera-ready and delivered to Lynn Landers-Dickinson, catequilcat@yahoo.com by Sept. 26th.

Clerks Needed: Ring clerks are needed and will be paid \$50 for their services. Do not deduct from entry fee. Lunch and beverages will also be provided.

Liability: The Cat-N-Around Cat Club and Iowa State Fair will not be responsible for loss, damage, injury or accidents to cats or property or assume liability for injury, loss, damage to any person, or property of persons (including, but not limited to exhibitors, judges, vendors and visitors).

Health & Condition: All cats & kittens must have their claws trimmed. We recommend that all cats & kittens be immunized against enteritis, rhinotracheitis, calici virus and rabies. Cat-N-Around Cat Club reserves the right to refuse entries that are not in the best interest of the show. If asked to leave because your cats or kittens are ill, or for violation of any ACFA or club rules, your entry fee will not be refunded.

Transfers: When a cat in the Open class receives the 4 winners ribbons needed to attain Champion status or if a cat qualifies as a Grand Champion on a Saturday, the owner MUST fill out a confirmation form and pay the required fee at the Master Clerk's table BEFORE the end of the show on Saturday. Transfers to Champion = \$7: transfers to a Grand Champion = \$12. Novice exhibitors ask for help if needed.

Clarity of Entries and Returned Checks: The entry clerk reserves the right to call collect about any entry requiring clarification. A \$25 fee will be charged for returned checks.
